13/05/2026

DIA 1 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Free day.



14/05/2026

DIA 2 - RIO

Christ the Redeemer, Sugarloaf and Santa Teresa Tour (8 hours)

If you want to explore even more of Rio de Janeiro, this is the ideal tour. We will pick you up at your hotel, and our first stop will be at Christ the Redeemer. From there, we'll head to Santa Teresa. After discovering this bohemian neighborhood, we'll visit the famous Selarón Steps, decorated with colorful tiles – perfect for photos! We'll also see the exterior of the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Sambadrome, and Maracanã Stadium, all great symbols of the city. Finally, we'll take a cable car ride up Sugarloaf Mountain, where you'll enjoy the best views of Rio. After the visit, transfer back to the hotel.

15/05/2026

DIA 3 - RIO

Guanabara Bay + Museum of Tomorrow Tour

A 5-hour tour combining sailing and culture. Starting with hotel transfer to the port, we'll board a catamaran for a 1.5-hour ride through Guanabara Bay, passing around 20 historic and iconic sites such as Sugarloaf, Botafogo, Flamengo, Urca, and imperial-era fortresses.

After that, we'll enjoy a 1.5-hour guided visit to the futuristic Museum of Tomorrow, designed by Santiago Calatrava, blending science, art, and technology in interactive exhibitions about past, present, and future. Return to the hotel afterwards.





16/05/2026

DIA 4 - ARRAIAL DO CABO

At 8:00 AM, departure from the Rio hotel towards Arraial do Cabo, home to some of the most beautiful beaches in Brazil.

We'll board a shared boat and sail through the crystal-clear waters of the "Brazilian Caribbean." Along the way, we'll see Pontal do Atalaia, Blue Grotto, and Nossa Senhora Crevice.

We'll stop at Cabo Frio Beach for free time to have lunch on your own. Return to Rio hotel by 5:00 PM.

17/05/2026

DIA 5 - RIO - PARATY

Paraty Historic City Tour

We'll explore the historic center of Paraty, with its preserved colonial atmosphere that lasted until the 1960s when the city was isolated. For about 2 hours, we'll visit baroque churches (Santa Rita, Nossa Senhora do Rosário, Matriz, and Nossa Senhora das Dores) and the Casa da Cultura, featuring exhibitions on local history. The tour ends back in the city center.



18/05/2026

DIA 6 - PARATY

Boat Tour Around the Islands

Highlights:

- Over 60 paradise islands
- Stunning natural scenery and crystal-clear waters
- Stops for swimming and snorkeling
- Four stops, approx. 40 minutes each

Stops itinerary:

1. Vermelha Beach – calm, clear waters
2. Blue Lagoon – a dazzling natural pool
3. Saco da Velha – preserved landscapes
4. Algodão Island – perfect for snorkeling

Duration: approx. 4 hours



19/05/2026

DIA 7 - PARATY

Jeep Tour to Serra da Bocaina National Park

After breakfast, departure at 10:30 AM in a 4x4 jeep.

First stop: Pedra Branca waterfalls, free time for nature and photos. Then to Vila da Penha, where we'll hike through the forest, visiting other falls like Tobogã and Poço do Inglês.

After free time for lunch, visit two artisanal distilleries on the Caminho D'Ouro trail: Pedra Branca and Engenho D'Ouro, producers of traditional Brazilian cachaça.

Return to Paraty in the afternoon.



20/05/2026

DIA 8 - PARATY - FOZ DO IGUAÇU

Breakfast, transfer to Rio airport, flight to Foz do Iguaçu (included). Transfer to hotel. Free afternoon.

21/05/2026

DIA 9 - FOZ DO IGUAÇU

Brazilian Side of Iguaçu Falls

Breakfast, then visit the Brazilian side of Iguaçu National Park, famous for the best panoramic views.

We'll walk along a 1,200m trail with views of the canyon and waterfalls like Rivadavia and Three Musketeers. The trail ends at the lower viewpoint of the Devil's Throat, where you'll see spectacular rainbows formed by the falls.

Approx. 2 hours visit. Return to hotel between 3-4 PM.

Optional: lunch at the park restaurant.



22/05/2026

DIA 10 - FOZ DO IGUAÇU

Argentinian Side of Iguazu Falls

Breakfast, then departure to Iguazu National Park (Argentina). From the Visitor Center, we'll board a small train to Puerto Macuco forest. A 100m descent leads to the canyon, where you may optionally take a speedboat ride through the rapids to the base of the Three Musketeers Falls and the Devil's Throat.

We'll continue exploring the park, visiting San Martín Falls – the second largest, accessible by boat. From San Martín Island, we'll walk along the Lower Circuit trail.

Return to hotel in the late afternoon.

23/05/2026

DIA 11 - FOZ DO IGUAÇU - MANAUS

Breakfast, transfer to the airport, flight to Manaus (included). Arrival and transfer to hotel. Free day.



24/05/2026

DIA 12 - MANAUS

Manaus City Tour

Breakfast, then guided tour through the historic center of Manaus.

Highlights include:

- Amazonas Opera House
- Rio Negro Palace
- São Sebastião Square & Church
- Municipal Market, divided into banana, fish, and general sections
Perfect for learning about history, culture, and local products.

Start of 4-night Cruise on the Rio Negro

Breakfast, transfer to the airport for flight home.


